Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §590-B, sub-§5 is enacted to read:

 5. Exemption. A resource recovery facility that burns less
than one ton per day or that has less than 15 cubic feet of burning area is exempt from this section and from rules adopted
by the board relating to incinerators or resource recovery facilities.

SUMMARY

14 This bill exempts resource recovery facilities that burn less than one ton per day or that have less than 15 cubic feet of burning area from testing requirements for resource recovery facilities and from rules adopted by the Board of Environmental 18 Protection relating to incinerators or resource recovery facilities.
