SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 175, L.D. 504, Bill, "An Act to Amend Certain Provisions Dealing with the Subjects of Juvenile Petition, Adjudication and Disposition"

Amend the bill by inserting after section 30 the following:


'Sec. 31. 25 MRSA §2003, sub-§1, ¶D, as amended by PL 1993, c. 524, §§5 and 7, is further amended by amending subparagraph (5), division (r) to read:

(r) Have you been adjudged to have committed the civil violation of possession of a useable amount of marijuana, butyl nitrite or isobutyl nitrite in violation of Title 22, section 2383 within the past 5 years?; and'

Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.
