SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 360, L.D. 505, Bill, "An Act to Establish a Tuition Rate for Education in the Unorganized Territory"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 3.

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment eliminates the General Fund cost of the bill by eliminating the portion of the bill that would have reduced General Fund revenue.

SUMMARY

The amendment eliminates the portion of the bill that precluded the Department of Education from including certain state retirement costs of the education in the unorganized territory program when preparing the education portion of the municipal cost component.
