
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**An Act to Increase the Certification Fee Cap for the Board of Geologists

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §4912, 2nd ¶**, as amended by PL 1995, c. 502,  
Pt. H, §34, is further amended to read:

6 The initial and renewal fees for certification as a  
geologist or soil scientist are set by the board in an amount not  
8 to exceed \$65 ~~\$80~~ annually.

10 **SUMMARY**

12 This bill increases the cap for initial and renewal fees for  
14 certification as a geologist or soil scientist in order to  
outsource the geologist exam.
