HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 367, L.D. 512, Bill, "An Act to Prohibit Liquor Licensing of an Establishment Managed by a Person with a Criminal Record"

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "\$703." in the first paragraph in the 2nd line (page 1, line 9 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "convicted" the following: 'within the past 5 years'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "\$703." in the first paragraph in the last line (page 1, line 11 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "revoked" the following: 'within the past 5 years'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

'**Sec. 2. Application.** This Act does not apply to any individual employed on or before the effective date of this Act.'

SUMMARY

This amendment limits the period for which employment is prohibited to 5 years from a violation or revocation. The amendment also exempts anyone employed on the effective date of the bill from the prohibition.
