2. Limits on voting authority. When only 2 supervisors are present at a regularly scheduled board meeting, the chair of the

meeting may appoint an associate supervisor present and with designated voting authority to serve as a supervisor for that

meeting, thereby establishing a quorum. The designated associate supervisor has full voting rights of a supervisor for that meeting.'

SUMMARY

8 This amendment clarifies that an associate supervisor may be granted voting authority only when a quorum is lacking at a regularly scheduled meeting.
