An Act to Provide Limited Voting Authority for Associate Supervisors of Maine's Soil and Water Conservation Districts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 2 Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §103 is enacted to read: 4 §103. Associate supervisors 6 By unanimous vote, the board of supervisors of a district established according to section 102 may appoint individuals with 8 training and experience relevant to the duties of the supervisors 10 to serve as associate supervisors. If a board of directors appoints one or more associate supervisors, the board shall maintain a current list of individuals appointed to serve in that 12 capacity and shall submit that list to the department. Employees of the district and contract providers to the district may not be 14 appointed as associate supervisors. 16 By unanimous vote of those present, the board of supervisors 18 may authorize an associate supervisor to vote on behalf of a supervisor who is absent from a regularly scheduled board 20 meeting. If only 2 supervisors are present at a regularly scheduled board meeting, the chair of the meeting may designate 22 an associate supervisor present and with authorized voting authority to serve as a supervisor for that meeting, thereby 24 <u>establishing a quorum.</u> 26 SUMMARY 28 This bill allows the supervisors of a soil and water

This bill allows the supervisors of a soil and water 30 conservation district to appoint associate supervisors and to authorize an associate supervisor to vote in place of an absent 32 supervisor.
