6	3. Rate of reimbursement. The Department of Corrections shall, on a quarterly basis and in a timely fashion, reimburse
8	each county at an-initial a rate of \$34 \$83.75 per prisoner per day fer-the-period-from-April-1,-1987,-to-June-30,-1987.
10	Beginning-July-1,-1987,-subsequent-rates-shall-be-established-as provided-in-subsection-5. A county desiring to change that rate
12	must petition the Legislature in accordance with the Constitution of Maine, Article IV, Part Third, Section 18.
14	Sec. 2. 34-A MRSA §1210, sub-§5, as amended by PL 1993, c.
16	431, §§1 to 3, is repealed.

22	This bill fixes the rate of reimbursement to counties for prisoners at \$83.75 per prisoner per day. It specifies that a county must petition the Legislature for any desired change in
