HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 374, L.D. 519, Bill, "An Act to Promote Water Skiing in the State"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in subsection 3 by inserting after paragraph B a new blocked paragraph to read:


'The commissioner may issue a permit under this subsection only if notice of the permit application is given to all municipalities that have jurisdiction over the body of water.'

FISCAL NOTE

The Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife will incur some minor additional costs to make certain notifications to municipalities. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.

SUMMARY

This amendment requires that before a permit is issued for a water-skiing course, notice must be given to all municipalities that have jurisdiction over the body of water.
