COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 381, L.D. 526, Bill, "An Act to Establish a Part-time Liquor License"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

General Fund	(\$178,300)	(\$183,300)

Adding the option for part-time liquor licenses will result in net reductions of General Fund revenue by \$178,300 in fiscal year 1997-98 and \$183,300 annually beginning in fiscal year 1998-99.

The additional costs associated with implementing the part-time licenses can be absorbed by the Department of Public Safety utilizing existing budgeted resources.

This amendment adds a fiscal note to the bill.
