10 facilities is \$79.75 per prisoner per day.

This amendment may also increase prosecutions for Class D crimes. If a jail sentence is imposed, the additional costs to the counties are estimated to be \$83.78 per day per prisoner. These costs are not reimbursed by the State. The number of prosecutions that may result in a jail sentence and the resulting costs to the county jail system are expected to be insignificant.

This amendment may also increase the indigent defense costs incurred by the Judicial Department. The amounts of additional General Fund appropriations that may be required can not be estimated at this time.

This amendment provides a penalty of life imprisonment or at least 5 years for any person who destroys the life of a child who is being born if that child otherwise would have lived. This amendment is based upon Texas law.
