HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to H.P. 390, L.D. 535, Bill, "An Act to Ban Partial Birth Abortions"

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "~~§1597-B.~~" in subsection 2 in the last line (page 1, line 28 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "purpose." and inserting in its place the following: 'purpose. A partial-birth abortion must be performed in a hospital or ambulatory surgical facility.'

SUMMARY

This amendment requires that all partial-birth abortions be performed in a hospital or ambulatory surgical facility. This will help to ensure that the mother receives the safest care available.
