2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2308, sub-§6**, as enacted by PL 1993, c.
683, Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, is amended to read:

6 **6. Penalty.** A violation of this section is a Class E crime
8 which that, notwithstanding Title 17-A, section 1301, is
punishable by a \$250 minimum fine for the first offense and a
10 ~~mandatory 30 day suspension of a driver's license for a 2nd~~
~~offense occurring within 3 years of the first offense.~~

12 **SUMMARY**

14 This bill removes the mandatory requirement that a person's
16 driver's license be suspended for 30 days for the 2nd violation
of passing a stopped school bus within 3 years of the first
18 offense.
