Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 2 Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2308, sub-§6, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683, Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, is amended to read: 4 б б. Penalty. A violation of this section is a Class E crime which <u>that</u>, notwithstanding Title 17-A, section 1301, is 8 punishable by a \$250 minimum fine for the first offense and-a mandatory--30-day--suspension-of--a--driver's--license-for--a--2nd offense-eccurring-within-3-years-of-the-first-offense. 10 12 SUMMARY 14 This bill removes the mandatory requirement that a person's 16 driver's license be suspended for 30 days for the 2nd violation of passing a stopped school bus within 3 years of the first offense. 18
