### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §1802, sub-§3 is enacted to read:

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3. Rebates prohibited. With respect to any repair paid for in whole or in part by an insurance company, a repair facility may not fail to charge all or any part of the deductible to be paid by an insured customer, or give away any rebate, gift, prize, premium, bonus, fee or other monetary or tangible thing to an insured customer or any person not in the employ of the repair facility as an inducement to have the repair made at the repair facility.

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#### **SUMMARY**

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This bill prohibits a motor vehicle repair facility from refunding a deductible to be paid by insured customers or providing rebates or other incentives to insured customers or other persons as an incentive to have a repair made at the repair facility with respect to repairs paid for in whole or in part by insurance companies.
