An Act Concerning the Fees Charged by the Secretary of State for Copies.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §86, 2nd ¶, as amended by PL 1995, c. 373, §1, 4 is further amended to read:

б For a certificate under the seal of the State, \$5 for a short form and \$10 for a special detailed certificate. For all copies of corporate, limited partnership and mark documents, the 8 rate of \$2 per page; and for all other copies, the rate-of--75¢ actual cost per page except for electronic copies, for which the 10 Secretary of State must receive the actual cost of production if such copies are prepared by the office of the Secretary of 12 State. Upon request, the office of the Secretary of State shall provide to any person the supporting data showing the calculation 14 of actual cost. The Secretary of State may reduce or waive the 16 fee for other governmental agencies and bodies;

SUMMARY

This bill provides that the Secretary of State must receive the actual cost per page for copies and the actual cost of production for electronic copies when those copies are prepared by the office of the Secretary of State. The Secretary of State currently receives 75¢ per page for most copies.
