2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 7 MRSA §632** is amended to read:

6 **§632. Labeling**

8 All eggs sold or offered for sale for human consumption by
10 any person, partnership, association, firm or corporation shall
12 must be labeled with the grade and size designation as set forth
in the Maine consumer grades, except as otherwise provided, and
must be clearly labeled with the name of the company that
produced the eggs.

14 **SUMMARY**

16 This bill requires all eggs to be labeled with the name of
18 the producer.
