SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 431, L.D. 581, "Resolve, to Establish the Commission to Determine the Adequacy of Services to Persons with Mental Retardation"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 5 and inserting in its place the following:

Sec. 5. Meetings. Resolved: That the commission may meet up to 4 times; and be it further'

Further amend the amendment in section 6 in the 4th line (page 3, line 9 in amendment) by striking out the following: "December 1, 1997" and inserting in its place the following: 'January 1, 1998'

Further amend the amendment in section 8 in the first line (page 3, line 17 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "members" the following: 'who are legislators'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section 9 and inserting in its place the following:

Sec. 9. Appropriation. Resolved: That the following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this resolve.
