

Sec. 1. 10 MRSA §1272, first ¶, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 115,
§1, is amended to read:

A business operating in this State may not display a social security number on a credit card, customer service card or debit card issued or distributed by that business on or after January 1, 1994 or on any correspondence sent by the business.

This bill prohibits businesses from using a customer's social security number on correspondence.
