

Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §4211, sub-§3-A is enacted to read:

3-A. Verification of construction. A subsurface waste water disposal system may not be operated unless the municipality has verified that the system was constructed according to the documentation submitted to the municipal officers before construction under subsection 3.

#### SUMMARY

This bill requires that a subsurface waste water disposal system may not be operated until the municipality has verified that the system was actually constructed according to the plan originally submitted for construction.
