Sec. 1. Department of Education to review laws. Resolved: Tha
the Department of Education, in consultation with the Main
Council on Vocational Education, shall review the laws governing
applied technology centers and regions and propose clarification
to those laws, including, but not limited to, listing all of the
proper sending schools to all of the applied technology center
and applied technology regions; and be it further

Sec. 2. Report. Resolved: That the Department of Education shall submit its report, along with any necessary implementing legislation, to the Joint Standing Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs no later than December 1, 1997.

SUMMARY

This resolve directs the Department of Education, in consultation with the Maine Council on Vocational Education, to review and propose clarifications to the laws governing applied technology centers and applied technology regions.
