HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 188, L.D. 606, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Off-track Betting Laws as They Pertain to Reduced Payments for Small Market Licensees"

Amend the amendment by inserting before section 1 the following:

'Sec. 1. 8 MRSA §275-K, sub-§§4 and 5 are enacted to read:

4. Certain commissions collected by an off-track betting facility prohibited. Upon the approval of a license of an off-track betting facility by the State Harness Racing Commission, an existing off-track betting facility may not charge or collect a commission from another off-track betting facility within a 35-mile radius of that existing off-track betting facility.

5. Certain commissions collected by a commercial race track prohibited. Upon the approval of a license of an off-track betting facility by the State Harness Racing Commission, an existing commercial race track may not charge or collect a commission from an off-track betting facility within a 50-mile radius of that commercial race track.'

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment provides that upon the approval of a license of an off-track betting facility by the State Harness Racing


