SUMMARY

This is the minority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Inland Fisheries and Wildlife.

This amendment strikes everything in the bill except the provision that transfers \$42,000 from the carrying balances of the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife in the current fiscal year for the purpose of reimbursing the Bureau of Warden Service for snowmobile enforcement expenditures that were in excess of amounts budgeted.
