26	FISCAL NOTE
28	This bill may increase prosecutions for Class C crimes. Sentences of more than 9 months imposed for Class C crimes must
30	be served in state correctional institutions. The cost to the State per sentence is \$53,033 based upon an average length of
32	stay of 1 year and 10 months. The State also must reimburse counties for sentences served in county jails of 9 months or less
34	for Class C crimes.
36	The Judicial Department may require additional General Fund appropriations to cover indigent defense costs related to these
38	new cases. The amounts can not be estimated at this time. The additional workload and administrative costs associated with the
40	minimal number of new cases filed in the court system can be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial
42	Department. The collection of additional fines may also increase General Fund revenue by minor amounts.'
