Police Training Academy to begin as early as July 1, 1997 instead of September 8, 1997. Unless the carry forward balance is at least \$145,546, the Maine State Police Training Academy may not start.

If \$145,546 is carried forward within the Highway Fund State Police program and the Maine State Police Training Academy begins early, the General Fund cost is estimated at \$87,094 in fiscal year 1997-98. Sufficient General Fund appropriations remain within that program since the General Fund savings associated with the delay of the Maine State Police Training Academy by Public Law 1997, chapter 25 was not deappropriated.'
