14	This bill will require the revision of the regulation of employment poster by the Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor
16	Standards. A General Fund appropriation of \$11,259 in fiscal year 1997-98 is required for printing and mailing costs. If
18	other bills are enacted that also require changes to this poster, the cost properly allocated to this bill can be reduced.
20	This bill may increase the number of civil suits filed in
22	the court system. The additional workload and administrative costs associated with the minimal number of new cases filed can
24	be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial Department. The collection of additional filing fees may also
26	increase General Fund revenue by minor amounts.
28	SUMMARY

	This amendment strikes from the original bill the provision
32	that includes parent-teacher conferences among the authorized reasons for family medical leave. It also adds an appropriation
34	section and a fiscal note to the bill.
