

2 **Sec. 1. Retirement plan. Resolved:** That the Department of  
Public Safety shall convene a task force for the purpose of  
4 studying the issue of a retirement program for firefighters. The  
task force shall:

6 1. Examine established retirement programs for similar  
workers within the State;

8 2. Obtain and examine retirement programs from other states;

10 3. Discuss and assess the positive and negative issues  
12 involved in establishing a retirement program;

14 4. Examine Legislative Document No. 1323, H.P. 926 "An Act  
to Establish the Maine Volunteer Firefighters Retirement System"  
16 from the First Regular Session of the 115th Legislature; and

18 5. Discuss other issues that are relevant to the study; and

**Sec. 2. Report. Resolved:** That the task force shall report  
22 recommendations made pursuant to section 1, including any  
proposed legislation to develop a retirement program for  
24 firefighters, to the Joint Standing Committee on Labor by January  
26 1, 1998.
