18	Amend the amendment by striking out all of the fiscal note
20	and inserting in its place the following:
22	'FISCAL NOTE
24	The Department of Conservation will incur some minor additional costs to submit a written policy to the Legislature
26	which allows a forest ranger to carry a weapon. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.
28	The written policy that is developed could result in
30	significant General Fund costs. A policy that requires all forest rangers to carry a department issued weapon could result
32	in additional General Fund appropriations of as much as \$200,000 for the first year of implementation and approximately \$70,000
34	for every year thereafter. However, if the policy allows forest rangers to carry their own weapons and to bear the cost of any
36	required training, then the additional costs would be minimal.'
