SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 489, L.D. 660, "An Act to Opt out of the Federal Requirement to Use Reformulated Fuel"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 3.

**FISCAL NOTE**

**APPROPRIATIONS/ALLOCATIONS**

General Fund (\$7,250)

This amendment removes the General Fund appropriation of \$7,250 in fiscal year 1998-99 which is necessary for the Department of Environmental Protection to cover the costs of conducting a public hearing and the costs of conducting a required comparative risk study. The department will have to accomplish these responsibilities during fiscal year 1998-99 within existing resources.

**SUMMARY**

This amendment strikes the General Fund appropriation of \$7,250 in fiscal year 1998-99 for the Department of Environmental Protection.
