An Act to Amend the Laws Pertaining to Motor Vehicle Financial Responsibility and Insurance.

2	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 4	Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §1605, sub-§1, ¶C, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683, Pt. A, §2 and Pt. B, §5, is amended to read:
6	C. Be in the amount or limit of at least:
8	(1) $\$10,000-101$ for damage to property, $\$25,000$ ;
10	(2) <b>\$20,000for</b> <u>For</u> injury to or death of any one person <u>, \$50,000</u> ; and
12	- (3) <b>\$40,000-for</b> one accident resulting in injury
14	to or death of more than one person, $100,000$ , ; and
16	(4) For medical payments pursuant to section 1605-A, \$1,000.
18	Sec. 2. 29-A MRSA §1605-A is enacted to read:
20	<u>§1605-A. Medical payments</u>
22 24	<b>1. Requirement.</b> A motor vehicle liability policy covering a private passenger automobile and issued for a motor vehicle
26	registered or principally garaged in this State must provide coverage in an amount equal to or greater than \$1,000 per person
28	for medical costs incurred as a result of injuries sustained in an accident involving the insured vehicle by the driver and
30	passengers in that vehicle. The coverage required by this section only applies to medical costs incurred during one year following the date the injuries are sustained.
32	2. Exception. This section does not apply to:
34	A. A policy insuring more than 4 automobiles, nor to
36	any policy covering a garage, automobile sales agency, repair ship, service station or public parking place; or
38	B. Medical costs for injuries to any person having
40	equivalent medical coverage.

44	SUMMARY
<b>46</b> 48	This bill increases the minimum limits of insurance needed to operate a motor vehicle. The bill also requires that insurance for medical payments be obtained.

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
