COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 219, L.D. 678, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Laws Relating to Auctioneers"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

The repeal of the fee exemption for certain auctioneers will increase license fee collections. The estimated increases of annual dedicated revenue to the Board of Licensing of Auctioneers within the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation is \$5,900 beginning in fiscal year 1997-98.'
