Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 7 MRSA §3911, as amended by PL 1987, c. 643, §1, is further amended to read:

6 §3911. Dogs not to run at large

8 It is unlawful for any dog, licensed or unlicensed, to run at large, except when used for hunting. <u>Any dog not in a house</u> 10 <u>or other enclosure must be tied or kept on a leash at all times,</u> <u>even on the owner's or keeper's property.</u> The owner or keeper of 12 any dog found running at large shall-be <u>or not tied or on a leash</u> <u>is</u> subject to the penalties provided in this chapter. 14

SUMMARY

18 Any dog, except when used for hunting, must be tied or kept on a leash at all times, even on the owner's or keeper's property.
