COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 508, L.D. 699, Bill, "An Act to Clarify the General Powers of Attorney"

Amend the bill in section 1 by inserting at the end the following: 'Nothing in this section may be construed to broaden or add to any powers specifically enumerated in a durable health care power of attorney, whether or not the durable health care power of attorney is incorporated within any other power of attorney.'

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that a grant of general authority in a power of attorney does not broaden or add to a durable health care power of attorney.
