An Act to Authorize the Department of Transportation to Cut Brush and Trees along a Highway at the Request of a Business.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 23 MRSA §955 is enacted to read:

<u>§955. Removal of visual obstructions</u>

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At the request of a business, the department may trim, cut down and remove trees and brush located in the right-of-way of a state or state aid highway that decrease the visibility of the business from the highway. A business requesting the services of the department in accordance with this section shall reimburse the department for all costs associated with the requested service.

SUMMARY

18 This bill allows the Department of Transportation to remove trees and brush within the right-of-way of a state or state aid 20 highway when a business requests the service to increase visability of the business from the highway.
