18 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "// to H.P. 546, L.D. 737, Bill, "An 20 Act to Create an Apprentice Registration Category and to Exempt Certain Persons from Licensure under the Propane and Natural Gas 22 Act"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act to Create a Helper Registration Category, to Exempt Certain Persons from Licensure under the Propane and Natural Gas Act and to Eliminate the Tagging Requirement'

Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 6 in the 32 first line (page 1, line 11 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "apprentice" and inserting in its place the following: 34 'helper'

36 Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 6 in the 3rd line (page 1, line 13 in L.D.) by striking out the following: 38 "apprentice. An apprentice" and inserting in its place the following: 'helper. A helper'

Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 6 in the 5th line (page 1, line 15 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "<u>licensed person</u>," and inserting in its place the following: '<u>licensed person on-site.</u>'

6th line (page 1, line 16 in L.D.) by striking out the following:
48 "apprentices" and inserting in its place the following: 'helpers'

Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 6 in the first blocked paragraph in the 2nd line (page 1, line 19 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "apprentice" and inserting in its place the following: 'helper'

Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 6 in the
2nd blocked paragraph in the 5th line (page 1, line 25 in L.D.)
by striking out the following: "apprentice" and inserting in its
place the following: 'helper'

Further amend the bill by inserting after section 2 the following:

'Sec. 3. 32 MRSA §14808, sub-§4, as enacted by PL 1995, c. 389, §4, is amended to read:

4. Limited operator's license; training. The on-site owner
or operator of a dispensing station must hold a limited operator's license issued biennially by the board. The board
20 shall set by rule the requirements for obtaining the limited license. The holder of the limited license is responsible for
22 training other dispensing station employees and documenting that training.

The training for the limited license must include a manual prepared by a regional propane gas association, a video prepared by a national propane gas association or equivalent materials approved by the board. The training documentation must be kept at the station. The-en-site-owner-or-operator-of-the-dispensing station-is-responsible-for-compliance-and-is-subject-to-section 14809-

Sec. 4. 32 MRSA §14809, as enacted by PL 1995, c. 389, §4, is repealed.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

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collected by the Propane and Natural Gas Board within the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation. The estimated increases of dedicated revenue are \$3,500 and \$700 in fiscal years 1997-98 and 1998-99, respectively.

6 The repeal of tagging requirements for the installation of propane and natural gas equipment will result in the loss of 8 dedicated revenue from tag fees. The estimated loss of revenues to the Propane and Natural Gas Board is at least \$20,750 and 10 \$25,000 in fiscal years 1997-98 and 1998-99, respectively. These revenue losses will be partially offset by the aforementioned 12 revenue increases but will significantly reduce the board's overall resources. The board's remaining revenue sources will be 14 adequate to meet its anticipated expenditure needs.

16 The Propane and Natural Gas Board will incur some minor additional costs to adopt certain rules pertaining to the 18 registration of propane and natural gas helpers. These costs can be absorbed within the board's existing budgeted resources.'

SUMMARY

24 This amendment changes all references to "apprentice" to "helper." This amendment also adds the words "on-site" to ensure 26 that all work performed by a helper on-site is done under the direct and continuous supervision of a licensed individual. This 28 amendment repeals the tagging requirement for the installation of propane and natural gas equipment. The amendment also adds a 30 fiscal note to the bill.
