Repeal of the Lobster Promotion Council and the license б surcharges to support the council's purposes will reduce dedicated revenue to the Lobster Promotion Fund by \$288,750 and 8 \$395,000 in fiscal years 1997-98 and 1998-99, respectively. Deallocations of these same amounts are included to reflect the

10 elimination of the council and the dedicated revenue.'
