#### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §12004-H, sub-§14, as enacted by PL 1991, c. 523, §1, is repealed.

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Sec. 2. 5 MRSA §13071-A, sub-§2, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 181, §1, is amended to read:

2. Organizations represented. The council consists of one representative from each of the following: the Department of 10 Marine Resources; the Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural 12 Resources; Maine State Film Commission; Maine Tourism Commission; Department of Economic and Community Development, Office of 14Business Development; State Planning Office; University of Maine Blueberry Advisory Committee; Lobster--Promotion-Councily Maine Potato Board; Maine Dairy Promotion Board; and the Maine 16 Publicity Bureau. The Commissioner of Economic and Community Development may designate other appropriate organizations. 18

### 20 Sec. 3. 12 MRSA §6455, as amended by PL 1993, c. 545, §§1 to 6, is repealed. 22
