Sec. 1. Naming a portion of Route 26 from Newry to Upton.

Resolved: That the portion of Route 26 extending from the intersection of Route 2 and Route 26 in Newry to the New Hampshire state line in Upton be designated the "Bernard Powers Highway." The citizens of that area, in consultation with the Department of Transportation, may create and erect a plaque along the highway in commemoration of Bernard Powers' years of service as a State Highway Patrolman.
