2 **Resolved:** That the portion of Route 26 extending from the
4 intersection of Route 2 and Route 26 in Newry to the New
6 Hampshire state line in Upton be designated the "Bernard Powers
8 Highway." The citizens of that area, in consultation with the
Department of Transportation, may create and erect a plaque along
the highway in commemoration of Bernard Powers' years of service
as a State Highway Patrolman.
