SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 562, L.D. 753, Bill, "An Act to Allow Police to Take Intoxicated Persons into Custody"

Amend the amendment in section 1 by striking out all of the first line (page 2, line 14 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 17 MRSA §2005 is enacted to read:'

Further amend the amendment in section 1 by striking out all of that part designated "§2006."

Further amend the amendment in section 4 in the 6th line (page 4, line 49 in amendment) by striking out the following: "\$1,100" and inserting in its place the following: '\$770'

Further amend the amendment in section 4 in the 7th line (page 4, line 50 in amendment) by striking out the following "1,000" and inserting in its place the following: '700'

FISCAL NOTE


This amendment eliminates the reduction in civil suits with the associated minor administrative savings to the courts and minor increase of General Fund revenue from filing fees.

This amendment removes the provision that specifies that a law enforcement officer is not liable in a civil action for failing to provide assistance to a person intoxicated in a public place if that person refuses the law enforcement officer's assistance. It also incorporates the changes made in Senate Amendment "A" to Committee Amendment "A" to Legislative Document 753 that correct figures in the appropriation section of the committee amendment.
