COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 576, L.D. 767, Bill, "An Act to Clarify Sanitary District and Sewer District Authority to Adopt Impact Fees"

Amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 3 in the first line (page 1, line 18 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "4354" the following: ', subsection 2'

Further amend the bill in section 3 in subsection 10 in the last line (page 1, line 24 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "4354" the following: ', subsection 2'

SUMMARY

This amendment, which is the minority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Natural Resources, specifies that it is the restrictions on the imposition of impact fees, and not the home rule authority to adopt impact fees, that apply to sanitary districts and sewer districts as well as to municipalities.
