Current law requires a person to have a license issued by the Commissioner of Marine Resources in order to operate aquaculture pens. The commissioner may grant an exemption for 18 legitimate research for a term not to exceed 2 years. This bill repeals the law that provides that legitimate research does not include commercial aquaculture production of marine organisms.
