Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 2 Sec. 1. 37-B MRSA §1065, sub-§5, as enacted by PL 1989, c. 545, §1, is amended to read: 4 Correction of unsafe conditions. 6 5. After receiving a report on a dam from a state dam inspector, if the director determines that a dam is an imminent threat to the safety of the 8 public, the director may order the owners, lessees or persons in control of the dam to make alterations to the dam or its 10 operations, including, but not limited to: 12 Breach or removal of the dam; Α. 14 B. Repair or maintenance of the dam; 16 C. Operation of the dam in a specified manner; 18 Preparation of and adherence to an emergency operations D. 20 plan satisfactory to the agency; or 22 Ε. Maintenance of appropriate records relating to water levels, dam operation and dam maintenance. 24 When the director issues an order under this subsection, the director shall ensure that a state dam inspector is available to 26 provide technical assistance to the owners, lessees or persons in 28 control of the dam and to the municipality in which the dam is located. 30 Sec. 2. ### SUMMARY

12 This bill requires that a state dam inspector be available to provide technical assistance to the owners, lessees or persons in control of a dam or to a municipality in which a dam is located if the Director of the Maine Emergency Management Agency orders the owners, lessees or persons in control of the dam to correct unsafe conditions.

The bill also provides a General Fund appropriation for a 20 dam inspector position.
