## SUMMARY

This bill updates the current list of state endangered and threatened species, which has been in effect since 1986. Current law requires a list of endangered and threatened wildlife to be created and maintained based on factors contributing to the risk of extirpation in this State. This list is created based on scientific, objective criteria and indicates biological status only, not management actions or habitat protection initiatives.
