For purposes of this section, the term "gift" has 20 the same meaning as in section 19, subsection 1, paragraph E, except that the exclusion provided in section 19, subsection 1, 22 paragraph E, subparagraph (1) does not apply.'

This amendment, a minority report of the committee, extends 32 the prohibition against accepting gifts or soliciting campaign contributions from certain persons to the Secretary of State, 34 Attorney General and State Auditor.
