Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 15 MRSA §5821, sub-§6-A is enacted to read:

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6-A. Property used in violation of other laws. All property used in, intended for use in or acquired with the profits of a crime not otherwise specified in this section;

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### SUMMARY

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This bill expands the types of criminal assets that may be forfeited by including all property used in, intended for use in or acquired with the profits of any crime not already specified in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 15, section 5821.

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
