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STATE OF MAINE SENATE 118TH LEGISLATURE FIRST SPECIAL SESSION

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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 229, L.D. 798, Bill, "An Act to Protect the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife from Unfunded Mandates"

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Amend the bill in section 1 in the first line (page 1, line 3 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "~~§7018~~" and inserting in its place the following: '~~§7019~~'

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Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "~~§7018.~~" in the first line (page 1, line 5 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "~~§7018.~~" and inserting in its place the following: '~~§7019.~~'

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Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

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FISCAL NOTE

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If the Legislature enacts new mandates for the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife after the effective date of this bill, those mandates must include authorization for the department to collect the full cost from those individuals who use or benefit from the new mandated service or program.'

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SUMMARY

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This amendment changes a section number to avoid a conflict with legislation enacted earlier in this legislative session and adds a fiscal note to the bill.
