SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 230, L.D. 799, Bill, "An Act to Limit the Type of Hunting Equipment Used by Hunters Who Have Already Tagged a Deer"


Amend the bill in section 3 by striking out all of paragraph N (page 1, lines 22 to 27 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'N. Has already tagged a deer and hunts in November by any method other than with a shotgun, unless the person killed and tagged a deer in the September special archery deer season. This paragraph does not apply to hunting in the unorganized territory.'

SUMMARY

This amendment provides that the prohibition on hunting with certain types of equipment applies only in November to hunting by any method other than with a shotgun. This amendment strikes the exemption for a moose permittee or subpermittee and adds an exemption for a person who killed and tagged a deer in the September special archery deer season. The amendment also provides that this prohibition does not apply to hunting in the unorganized territory.
