8	rates that promote economic development and interexchange carrier competition and that are based on the forward looking economic
10	cost of providing the service. For purposes of this section, "access rates" means the rates that an interexchange carrier pays
12	for access to a local exchange carrier's facilities and services in order to provide interexchange service in the State.
