SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 244, L.D. 813, Bill, "An Act to Define the Projects That Public Works Departments May Undertake Without Procuring the Services of a Registered Professional Engineer"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "~~§1254.~~" in subsection 1 in the 2nd line from the end (page 1, line 40 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "\$100,000" the following: 'the work is a normal maintenance activity routinely performed by that department or political subdivision or county, city, town, township or plantation'

Further amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "~~§1254.~~" in subsection 2 in the last line (page 1, line 46 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "or rule" the following: 'or if the project involves construction of new facilities or substantial capacity improvements to existing facilities'

SUMMARY

This amendment further conditions the times when a registered professional engineer is not required for construction of public works to require that the work is of the normal maintenance work routinely performed by the department or other
